3. Profile of skills and competences

A holder of the certificate:

- deals with all children, parents, colleagues and others in a positive, constructive manner
- · observes the child's behavior, reflects on it and adjusts his actions accordingly
- offers children a varied leisure time, encourages their development, assumes their talents and entrepreneurial spirit
- supports the child in all his activities
- provides opportunities for children to practise their social skills, encourages positive interactions between them and sets boundaries
- · recognises and responds to the child's socio-emotional needs
- provides a stimulating, safe, hygienic and healthy play environment for children
- collaborates with parents and recognises them as primary educators
- cooperates with others as a function of the child's care
- cooperates, gives feedback and makes agreements
- · reflects on operations and contributes to improving childcare
- organises and supervises meal times (afternoon snack, (possibly) lunch on Wednesday)
- organises moments of rest and exercise
- cares for children according to their needs

Entry requirements 1

For the professional practice of 'School-age child supervisor', having the following certificates and/or meeting the following conditions is a legal requirement:

- Attestation of knowledge of life-saving action with children as stipulated in BVR of 23 February 2001 on the conditions for approval and subsidy of day-care centres and services for foster families (and amendments)
- Attestation of medical suitability as stipulated in BVR of 23 February 2001 on the conditions for approval and subsidy of crèches and services for foster families (and amendments)
- Be at least 18 years of age as stipulated in BVR of 23 February 2001 on the conditions for approval and subsidy of day-care centres and services for foster families (and amendments)
- Extract from the criminal register, model 2 as stipulated in BVR of 23 February 2001 on the conditions for the recognition and subsidising of day nurseries and services for foster families (and amendments)
