3. Profile of skills and competences

The occupational standard was developed and approved by the sectoral social partners.

A holder of the certificate of professional competence can:

draw:

- takes body measurements according to the NBN EN 13402-1 standard;
- adds margins to measurement results;
- provides for supporting lines and points using the right formulas and the measurement results;
- connects the supporting points into a basic lineation;
- applies the proportions of the drawing to the basic pattern;
- copies each part of the pattern separately so that all parts together form an exact copy of the original pattern;
- provides each part with cuts, holes and seam values according to the further production process;
- provides small pattern parts depending on the model.

The candidate knows:

- how to calculate shrinkage values;
- how to calculate pleats.

grade:

- follows grading codes and a measurement table to the millimetre;
- grades the pattern proportionally;
- after grading checks whether all pattern parts fit together.

The candidate knows:

- how to calculate grading codes.

act professionally:

- recognises all errors in a pattern;
- recognises all errors in a finished garment;
- corrects all design errors in a pattern;
- processes adjustments after fitting;
- processes improvements and adjustments in the data on the pattern parts and the pattern list;
- provides interested parties with information on changes or errors which are not the result of the drawing process.

The candidate knows:

- which possible errors may occur in a pattern and a finished garment.

Explanation

The purpose of this document is to provide additional information on the specific certificate and has no legal status of itself. It is based on Council resolution 93/C 49/01 of 3 December 1992 on the transparency of qualifications, on Council resolution 96/C 224/04 of 15 July 1996 on the transparency of vocational training certificates and on Recommendation 2001/613/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 July 2001 on mobility within the Community for students, persons undergoing training, volunteers, teachers and trainers.
