- works with an eye for safety, the environment, quality and welfare
- edits or adapts parts
- prepares the vehicle as part of the work
- checks the vehicle in the course of maintenance
- performs simple repairs and replacements as part of maintenance and/or express service interventions
- assembles simple accessories (car radio in a pre-wired vehicle, plug & play systems,...)
- prepares the vehicle for inspection by the technical inspectorate
- prepares new and second-hand cars for delivery to customers
